#### "CREATION CARE CORNER:"

The leaves on our trees are beginning to change from green to other colors. We know that this means autumn has begun. This transformation of beauty also creates headaches for homeowners, between the time spent raking, bagging and leaf blowing.

This natural, yearly cycle doesn't have to be a nuisance. When shredded and spread across a landscape, dead leaves infuse the soil with more than a dozen vital nutrients – making them much more effective than synthetic fertilizers. They also insulate the soil, retain moisture, suppress weeds, and prevent soil compunction.

Mulching with leaves to get desirable results needs to be done in an effective way. Avoid spreading whole leaves in a thick layer. This will have a negative effect on the soil, blocking out sunlight and trapping water underneath. Instead, shred leaves into small dime-size pieces before spreading them. You can do so by simply running them over with your lawn mower. An increasingly popular method is investing in an electric leaf mulcher. Ear and face protections are recommended because of the large amounts of dust and noise that is generated.

Flower beds and vegetable gardens will thrive with a 2-inch layer of shredded leaves. Trees and shrubs require a deeper layer, maybe 4 inches. Also, the shredded mixture can be left directly on your lawn. Blend the leaves well into the base of the grass for best results.







# Holy Family Parishioners taking JustFaith Sacred Air: Climate and Energy Program.

Fourteen parishioners are meeting once a week for ten weeks to learn more about caring for creation. The program goals are:

- Understand the basic principles of the climate crisis: what is it and what is causing it.
- Learn about the disproportionate effects of the climate crisis on poor communities.
- Practice noticing God's presence with us through the Holy Spirit.
- Develop a plan for addressing the climate crisis through advocacy, grassroots and parish-based organizing, and daily decision-making.







# Haiti Ministry Needs Four New Teacher Sponsors.

For the past sixteen years, the Holy Family Haiti Committee has provided the salaries for forty teachers, cooks, staff, and principals for the Thomas Quinlan Primary and Middle School and four surrounding chapel schools. Currently teachers receive \$75/month or \$900/year.




