"CREATION CARE CORNER:"

The Catholic Climate Covenant along with seven other major U.S. Catholic organizations, by way of a letter sent to President Biden, have endorsed the Call for the Climate Debt Relief campaign to mark the "Season of Creation," which ended October 4.

The administration is requesting to use debt relief as a means to "unlock critical funding" for countries most vulnerable to the impacts of a rapidly heating world. They call on the U.S. to forgive or significantly restructure debts it holds with other nations as a central piece of its international climate policy at the upcoming U.N. Climate summit, COP28. Their argument is that such a move "can help developing nations meet their goals under the Paris Agreement, adapt to climate change, and address the loss and damage" these countries have suffered.

The Catholic letter stated that if we are serious about addressing the climate crisis and alleviating human suffering, then those of us whose basic needs are comfortably met must prioritize the interests of peoples who lack them. It is a central tenet of our Catholic Faith to prioritize the needs of our poor and vulnerable neighbors and to care for God's creation. Among them are the inhabitants of developing countries least responsible for the climate crisis who suffer the most devastating impacts.

Relieving countries of their debt obligations, or significantly lessening the burden, can redirect hundreds of billions of dollars toward investments into energy, resilience measures, and other climate solutions.




