What exactly does climate change mean? What does it have to do with right – or wrong – relationships with God, each other, all of humanity, and our Earth?



This means increasingly limited access to water, reduced crop yields, more widespread disease, increased frequency and intensity of natural disasters and conflicts arising from the decline of resources. The poorest among us on Earth will suffer the deepest hardships.

What does this have to do with God, faith, and right relationships? Global climate change is about the future of our common home and God's human family. It is about protecting both the human environment and the natural environment

We are making our relationship with God, with all of humanity, and our Earth right, and protecting them when we engage in these actions:

- Advocate with our legislators for laws, which protect the environment and promote its well being.


