

## CHURCH OF THE HOLY FAMILY BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP

Grief is the conflicting feelings caused by a change or an end in a familiar pattern or behavior; it is the normal and natural reaction to loss. Our Bereavement Support Group meets Tuesdays at 2:00 p.m. in the Parish Library. If you, or someone you know is grieving, please join us. These meetings will be confidential and held in a safe environment.

#### **CREATION CARE CORNER:**

Delivering a message Pope Francis had hoped to offer in person, Cardinal Pietro Parolin, the Vatican's top diplomat, on the second day of the opening of COP28, urged the United Nations climate summit in Dubai to achieve a "breakthrough" and become a turning point for the world by charting a path for the elimination of fossil fuels. The secretary of state for the Holy See read, "Now more than ever, the future of us all depends on the present that we now choose." He read, "It is essential that there be a breakthrough that is not a partial change of course, but rather a new way of making progress together."

Francis had been scheduled to be there in person – what would have been a first for a Pope – but canceled his trip on the advice of doctors as he is recovering from acute bronchitis. Parolin read, "We must answer now: Are we working for a culture of life or a culture of death? May this COP prove to be a turning point, demonstrating a clear and tangible political will that can lead to a decisive acceleration of ecological transition through means that meet three requirements: they must be efficient, obligatory and readily monitored. And achieved in four sectors:

- 1. Energy efficiency;
- 2. Renewable sources;
- 3. The elimination of fossil fuels, and
- 4. Education in lifestyles that are less dependent on fossil fuels."

Nations at COP28 were pressed to agree to the full phaseout of fossil fuels, but this outcome is seen as unlikely because others have proposed a "phasedown" of unabated fossil fuel use.

Pope Francis went on to say, "Climate change signals the need for political change. Let us emerge from the narrowness of self-interest and nationalism; these were approaches belonging to the past."

In his remarks, the Pope called the destruction of the environment "an offense against God" and "a sin," one that greatly endangers all human beings, especially the most vulnerable, and threatens to unleash a conflict between generations.

In closing Parolin read, on behalf of the Pope, "Let us leave behind our divisions and unite our forces and with God's help, let us emerge from the dark night of wars and environmental devastation in order to turn our common future into the dawn of a new and radiant day!"

#### RCIA is open to:

- Those adults who have not been Baptized and are spiritually looking
- Those adults who have been Baptized in a recognized <u>non-</u>Catholic Christian tradition
- Those adults who were Baptized Catholic but have not celebrated Eucharist and Communion

Participating in RCIA does not mean that you **have** to become Catholic, but it does help you discern as to whether God is calling you to join the Catholic Church.





#### Holy Family JCOC Team, serving HOPE one meal at a time.

The Judeo-Christian Outreach Center prepares to tear down their campus and build anew. The plan is to rebuild the outdated and inefficient campus dramatically increasing the number of people led out of hunger and homelessness. The new campus will consist of 38 affordable-housing units (300 sq. ft. each), a more flexible dining hall and safe space, and new administrative offices for JCOC's Rapid Rehousing and supportive programs to help participants achieve self-sufficiency.



The Holy Family JCOC team has committed to providing 120 meals once a month during the two year rebuild. Prepackaged meals are served in compostable containers for takeout service. The meals are assembled at Holy Family and taken to Mt. Olive Baptist Church for distribution.



# The Holy Family Prison Ministry Visits Onesimus Training Center


Members of the Holy Family Prison and Re-entry Ministry provided a meal to the men of the Onesimus Training Center. Eighteen men currently live in the house as they learn valuable skills and receive support in order to become successful and productive citizens. The Onesimus Training Center was founded in 1984. Brother Charles Warthen organizes this annual celebration. A potluck dinner is provided and each resident receives a gift card from the Holy Family Gifting Tree. The founder, Reverend Bill Twine is gifted \$1,500 from the Holy Family Prison Ministry to support the Training Center. The residents are greeted with prayer and words of encouragement. Each


resident had an opportunity to share their story with the group so everyone could appreciate their hope for the future.


