### **CREATION CARE CORNER:**

Around 11.2 billion tons of municipal solid waste are expected to be produced annually worldwide, according to the United Nations Environmental Program. That much waste would be enough to fill more than 800,000 Olympic-sized swimming pools. A sizeable fraction of that waste is currently burned. In the process, toxic gases are released into the atmosphere. The amount of particulate matter in the atmosphere is also increased as a result of this practice. Beside contributing significantly to emissions and thus global warming, these compounds also have the potential to be seriously harmful to the public's health.

#### Here Is What We Can Do To Reduce Landfill Waste:

- Instead of purchasing beverages in single-use plastic bottles, choose reusable containers.
- Cut back on purchases. The fewer products we buy, the less waste we produce.
- Reuse things. This reduces waste and conserves natural resources.
- Invest in products that use recycled materials to contribute to environmental improvement.
- Greener, more natural cleaning agents like vinegar and baking soda reduce waste produced by the countless cleaning product containers.
- Recycle. Recycling processes minimize waste, giving the items a second life.
- Compost (the opportunity is available at the Church of the Holy Family). Organic wastes, like yard and food waste, make up to 25 to 50% of overall waste.
- Discuss with neighbors and family the advantages of lowering the amount of solid waste created and learn more about the garbage and recycling policies your community has in place.




