- Can now send community coffee clippings - DEADLINE IS DEC 8

- Form sent out to teachers for feedback regarding campus project priorities
  - Results: Painting is top priority, playground equipment (this is coming - EPYB purchased balls, jump ropes, chalkboards, storage for balls; will get giant connect fours, games, toys for rocks, seating under trees).

  - Also navy with Sacred Heart lettering is planned for the front (design in progress)

    - Do classroom leadership presentations during this time with rewards for getting pledges
