A Message From Our Pastor




On this Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, our Gospel reading today, from Saint Luke reminds us how easy it is to fall

into the entrapment of judging others. Saint Luke refers to the story of Jesus encountering the woman who Simon, the Pharisee, considered a sinner. He was appalled that Jesus would allow the woman to anoint and kiss His feet: "If this man were a prophet, he would know who and what sort of woman this is who is touching him, that she is a sinner." Jesus asked the Pharisee, "Do you see this woman?" Through his eyes, Simon thought he did. In his judgment, he thought he had it all figured out. He was her judge and jury. In turn, Jesus turned to the woman, who truly did see her, and said, "Your sins are forgiven... Your faith has saved you; go in peace." The woman had showed Jesus great love and He forgave her sins. Jesus did not see just her outward appearance. He did not just see her sins. Jesus saw her - a woman who recognized the healing love and forgiveness of Christ. By spending more time seeking the forgiveness of Jesus for our sins, we will be less likely to judge others. Let us thank our loving Savior for the forgiveness He offers to us and let us share this gift with others. Have a most blessed week with the Lord.




