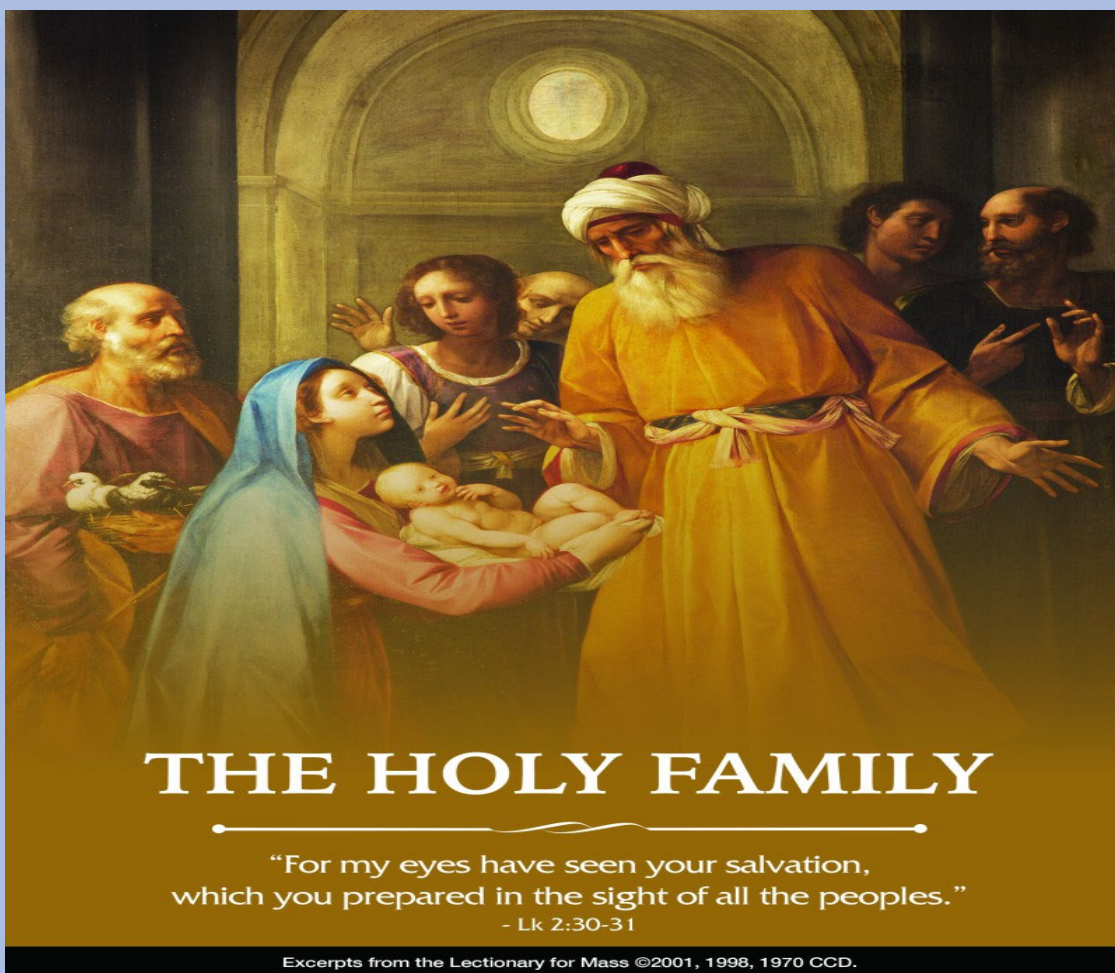

We will be having a complete renovation from wiring, plumbing, walls and shelving, to ADA requirements, roofing, windows and a more service oriented reconfiguration of the space.

We cannot say thank you enough to our St. Anne's parishioner family, who is always so supportive of our Bellview community and those in need. We have such dedicated volunteers and faithful, generous donors, that keep our food pantry going.

We will temporarily be serving the community out of the old Scout Hut across the parking lot. This building is also in much disrepair, but we have approval from the Diocese to use it as a temporary space for our food pantry. There has been a lot of noticeable work going on, to clear and prepare this space for the pantry.

In the coming weeks we will provide more specific costs, updates and needs. We are enclosing a special project envelope to get you familiar with it. And they will continue to be available in the church or office at any time.

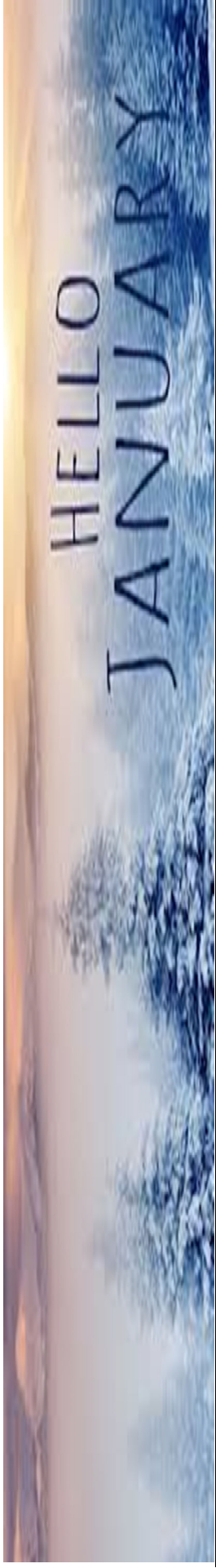

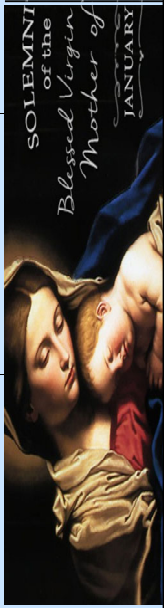
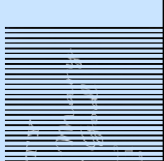
