

Stewardship Reflection Pentecost Sunday May 28th

Throughout our readings today, we see the amazing truth that the Holy Spirit gives us gifts and guidance in a very personal way. We are meant to use these gifts to build up the Body of Christ in a way that is unique to each one of us.


Our first reading, from the Acts of the Apostles, recalls the dramatic moment when the Holy Spirit was poured out upon the apostles. "Suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim."

Notice how personal and individual is this outpouring of the Spirit. This personalized way of "gifting" the apostles allowed them each to reach different people, sharing with them the "mighty acts of God." Embracing the stewardship way of life means that we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us in the best use of the unique gifts He has given to each of us, to accomplish the particular mission entrusted to us.

Jesus gives us this mission in our Gospel passage from John. "As the Father has sent me, so I send you." But we must not let this responsibility overwhelm us. Jesus Himself, tells us so — "Peace be with you."

As this Easter season comes to a close, let us be at peace. And let us resolve to lean on the Holy Spirit more and more as our guide through the stewardship way of life.

What is Memorial Day?

Originally called Decoration Day, Memorial Day is a day of remembrance for those who have lost their lives in our nation's service. Though some form of Memorial Day has been celebrated in various areas of the country beforehand, Memorial Day was officially proclaimed by General John Logan on May 5, 1868 and was observed later that month on May 30 when flowers were placed on the graves of both Union and Confederate soldiers who were buried at Arlington Cemetery.

Highlights of St. Anne Parish - Bellview

1979 - Stations of the Cross dedicated by Bishop William Houck of Jackson, MS.

\$8,000.00 donated for an altar in the Religious Heritage Chapel in State Capitol in Tallahassee

- 1979 Round-Up Office renovated from Rectory Garage
- 1980 Gazebo in church courtyard where parishioners gather after Mass, blessed by Bishop William Friend of Alexandria, LA
- 1980 \$40,000.00 given toward Catholic High School Me morial Stadium
- 1981 "Grindlwa1d" room added to the Rectory. Archbishop Oscar Lipscomb of Mobile blessed the newly constructed additional Round-Up Parking Area.
- 1982 Two-story Dwelling "Venard House" renovated and used for parish social functions, temporary 2nd rectory, blessed by Bishop John Rudin, visiting Maryknoll missionary.
- 1983 St. Anne's Bell tower completed, blessed by Bishop Paul F. Tanner, Diocese of St. Augustine. Statue of "Risen Christ" mounted atop bell tower dedicated to memory of Rocky Marciano

Bishop J_- Keith Symons. installed as second Bishop of Pensacola-Tallahassee Diocese. (Nov. 8)

1984 - Sacred Heart Shrine placed in new courtyard, dedicated by Bishop Symons ·

Preschool Education Program introduced at St. Anne's (Sisters Consolata and Mary Ellen - Sisters of St. Joseph Cottolengo)

- 1985 Bartley Larner donated his home and it was transport to St. Anne's grounds and converted into Convent. The playground area for preschool children fenced in and playground equipment built by parishioners New Gazebo built in center of Round-Up Picnic area.
- 1986 Death of Fr. John Licari's mother, Mrs. Aida Licari. August 23rd · Attending Bishops: · Bishop Symons, Bishop Friend, Bishop, Houck, and Archbishop Lipscomb.

The little church built by Sister John Joseph and her dedicated workers is now a permanent memorial to the incredible sacrifices of the zealous priests, sisters, brothers, and laypeople who envisioned a Catholic church in the Bellview area.




