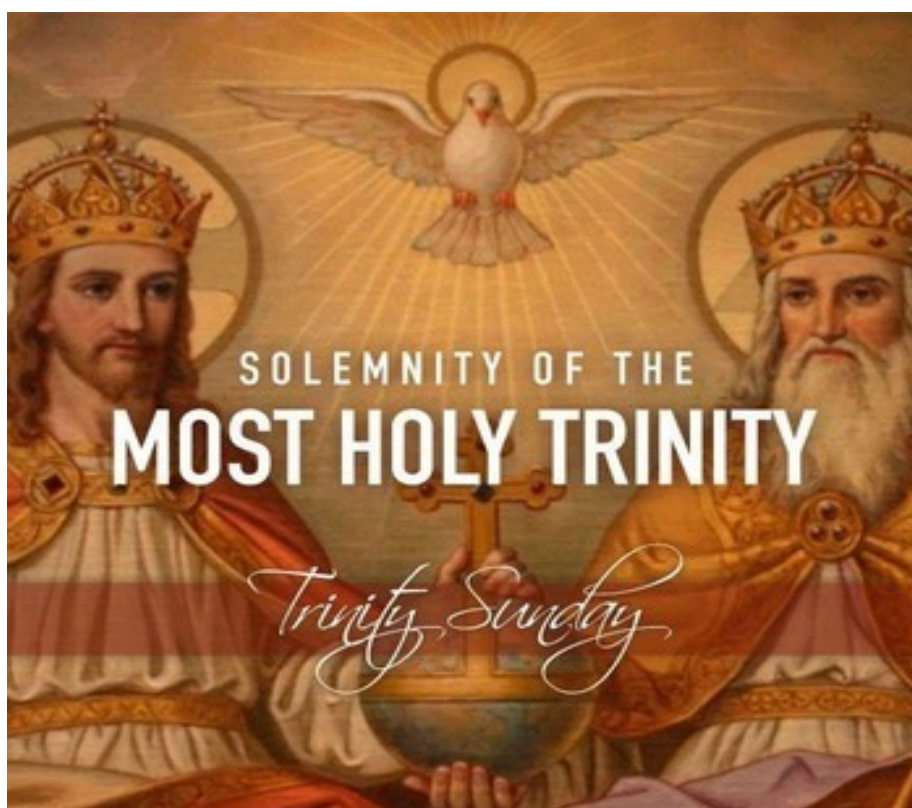

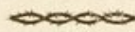
SACRED HEART of Jesus



Jesus' Sacred Heart represents the divine love He shares with the Father and the Holy Spirit, and the love He has for us. It also represents His physical human heart, the Word made flesh through the Incarnation.



Cross: The crucifixion, the ultimate sacrifice. "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son." (Jn 3:16)



Crown of Thorns: Jesus' suffering and agony on the cross, which He willingly endured for our sake.



Flames: Jesus' burning love for us and its purifying and transformational power.



Wound & Blood: The piercing of Jesus' side during His crucifixion. His precious blood spilled for our redemption.

June 24, the Nativity of Saint John the Baptist

Called from birth by the Lord, John matured in the Spirit and heralded the advent of the Messiah.

This feast, dating from the 4th century in both East and West, came to be celebrated, in accord with Lk 1:36, six months before the Lord's birth; Augustine found this date appropriate for, after the birth of John, daylight begins to grow shorter, whereas after Jesus' birth, it begins to increase.

Sacraments/Sacramentos Baptism/Bautismo: English PreBaptismal Class (children 0-6 years old) Parents must be registered and active a minimum of 6 months.

Choose appropriate godparent(s). At least one must be 16 years of age, confirmed and a practicing Catholic. If married, must be married in the Catholic Church. If single, must be living a chaste life. Godparents must be registered and active in a parish for a minimum of six months and present a letter documenting activity from their parish. Call to register 503-792-4231.

Clases Pre-Bautismales (Niños de 0-6 años)

Es necesario que los padres estén registrados y activos un mínimo de 6 meses.

Elija el Padrino (s) apropiado, al menos uno debe ser de 16 años de edad, confirmado, y católico practicando. Si es casado, debe ser casado en la Iglesia Católica. Si es soltero, debe vivir una vida casta y no cohabitando. Los padrinos deben estar registrados y activos en una parroquia durante un mínimo de tres meses y presentar una carta documentando la actividad de su parroquia. Favor de llamar para registrarse.

Marriage/Matrimonio

Couples must contact the office at least six months in advance. One party should be registered at our parish.

The Catholic party must be an active Catholic and participating in the life of the church. If the Catholic party planning to get married in our parish is not an active member in our parish, he or she should be participating actively in another Catholic parish. (The pastor will request a letter from your parish.)

Las parejas deben ponerse en contacto con la oficina por lo menos seis meses adelantado. Por lo menos uno de los dos debe estar registrado/a en nuestra parroquia. La pareja Católica debe ser un Católico activo y participando en la vida de la iglesia.
