A word from Fr. James

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we finally fully return to Ordinary Time and we see the familiar green vestments of the priest. In the gospel we return to our reading from the gospel of Luke, which we will continue to hear from until the end of the Liturgical Year in November.

Today, Luke tells us that as Jesus and those following him were proceeding on their journey to Jerusalem, someone called out, "I will follow you wherever you go." Jesus responds with some confusing words . . . "Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay his head.

When we follow Jesus, we are called to leave everything behind. When a person is a convert, this often can be easy to do. When you live a life not following Jesus, it is easy to see the things that need to be left behind, but what about when or if you have followed Jesus your whole life? What are you to leave behind?

This is where we can take a moment to invite the Holy Spirit to reveal to us what we might be holding on to that is keeping us from fully and freely following Jesus. Jesus tells us that the foxes and birds have a home, but he does not. When we have a home, we have a place to store things and collect things, but we often overdo it. Jesus is making his way back to the Father, his journey does not allow him to take anything with him, so neither does our journey.

May we follow Jesus freely, wherever he may call us and leave behind anything that holds us back!

Baptism/*Bautismo:* (children 0-6 years old) **Parents must be registered and active a minimum of 6 months.** Choose appropriate godparent(s). At least one must be 16 years of age, confirmed and a practicing Catholic. If married, must be married in the Catholic Church. If single, must be living a chaste life. Godparents must be registered and active in a parish for a minimum of six months and present a letter documenting activity from their parish. Call the office to register or if the children are older than age 7.

Elija el Padrino (s) apropiado, al menos uno debe ser de 16 años de edad, confirmado, y católico practicando. Si es casado, debe ser casado en la Iglesia Católica. Marriage/Matrimonio

Couples must contact the office at least six months in advance. One party should be registered at our Parish and must be an active Catholic and participating in the life of the church. If the Catholic party planning to get married in our parish is not an active member in our parish, he or she should be participating actively in another Catholic parish. (The pastor will request a letter from your parish.)





Saint of the Week

Saint Oliver Plunkett was the last Roman Catholic Martyr to die in England. He was canonized in 1975, the first new Irish saint in almost 700 years.

Oliver was born in Loughcrew, Oldcastle, County Meath in November 1625, the son of the Baron of Loughcrew. As a young man, he wanted to become a priest, but it was illegal to travel to the continent to enter seminary. Even so, he undertook the dangerous journey with four other young men and a Papal Envoy. They were pursued by English privateers, storms at sea, and robbers on land. However, Oliver entered Rome in 1647, and was admitted to the Irish College. He was an excellent student and was ordained on January 1, 1654. Oliver remained in Rome, studied law and served as chaplain at Spienza University, ministered at Santo Spirito hospital, and cared for the poor and ill. By 1657 he was a professor of Theology and later of Apologetics or Controversies at Propaganda College.

The 1650s were a difficult time in for Catholics in Ireland, the majority of population, as Cromwell passed many penal laws against them, and the practice of Catholicism was banned. During this time Oliver was appointed by Irish bishops to be their agent in Rome. Following the Restoration of Monarchy, Pope Clement IX appointed Oliver Archbishop of Armagh and Primate of all Ireland 1669. Oliver returned to a country where the Catholic Church was in disarray and divided. He had to travel largely incognito and perform his duties in makeshift locations. He is credited with unifying the Church and in traveling across the eleven dioceses under his purview, confirming thousands, and ordaining several priests.

In 1673 persecution of Catholics was again on the rise and bishops were banned. Oliver went into hiding, but in 1679 he was arrested and charged with treason. He was hanged, drawn, and quartered at Tyburn in July 1681. Before his death he publicly forgave those responsible.
