#### A word from Fr. James

There are two things that I would like to bring to your attention, well three. FIRST, I hope that you are all drinking enough water during these hot summer days. It is important to stay hydrated! **SECOND**, the bishops of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have given us an amazing opportunity over the next three years with the National Eucharistic Revival. Starting this past Corpus Christi, the Church in the U.S. began the first phase of this revival which will focus on diocesan renewal. From June 11, 2023, to July 17, 2024, will be a year which will focus on Parish Renewal. From July 17 to July 21, 2024, there will be a National Eucharistic Congress taking place in Indianapolis. From July of 2024 to Pentecost 2025 will be a year focused on going out in mission. This renewal will focus on our belief as Catholics in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist and what that means for us as individuals and as a Church. Please stay tuned to the bulletin for activities here in our diocese and our parish during this time focusing on the Eucharist. Check out www.eucharisticrevival.org for more information. **THIRD,** some of you may have seen this news from the Archdiocese; starting this fall, there will be a shift in the ages for our youth to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Typically, in the Archdiocese Confirmation preparation is covered in a two-year process for those that are in the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Students typically receive the sacrament in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade. Starting this year, by recommendation of the priests of the Archdiocese, Archbishop Sample announced that the age of confirmation will be shifting to 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade, with students receiving the sacrament in the spring of the 7th grade year. It will remain a two year process. There will also be a shift in how classes are taught with a greater emphasis on service and participation in the life of the parish instead of sitting in class every week; for example, attending and involvement in the ministries of the Church: altar serving, lectors, hospitality ministers, and dedicated service opportunities like food pantry, mission trips, service at our chicken dinners. There will be opportunity for bible study and prayer groups, opportunities for evangelization and opportunities for the teens to build relationships with their peers in the parish. If you have a child that will be in 6, 7, 8, or 9<sup>th</sup> grade this fall, please send your child and family name to Katie Phelan at the parish office so you won't miss registration.

Hay dos cosas que me gustaría llamar su atención, bueno, tres. PRI-MERO, espero que todos estén bebiendo suficiente agua durante estos calurosos días de verano. ¡Es importante mantenerse hidratado! SEGUNDO, los obispos de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos nos han brindado una oportunidad increíble durante los próximos tres años con el Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional. A partir de este pasado Corpus Christi, la Iglesia en los EE. UU. inició la primera fase de este avivamiento que se centrará en la renovación diocesana. Del 11 de junio de 2023 al 17 de julio de 2024, será un año que se centrará en la Renovación Parroquial. Del 17 al 21 de julio de 2024, se llevará a cabo un Congreso Eucarístico Nacional en Indianápolis. Desde julio de 2024 hasta Pentecostés 2025 será un año enfocado en salir en misión. Esta renovación se centrará en nuestra creencia como católicos en la presencia verdadera de Jesús en la Eucaristía y lo que eso significa para nosotros como individuos y como Iglesia. Estén atentos al boletín para conocer las actividades aquí en nuestra diócesis y nuestra parroquia durante este tiempo centrado en la Eucaristía. Visite www.eucharisticrevival.org para obtener más información. TERCERO, algunos de ustedes pueden haber visto esta noticia de la Arquidiócesis: a partir de este otoño, habrá un cambio en las edades para que nuestros jóvenes reciban el Sacramento de la Confirmación. Por lo general, en la Arquidiócesis, la preparación para la Confirmación se cubre en un proceso de dos años para aquellos que están en el noveno y décimo grado. Los estudiantes típicamente reciben el sacramento en el décimo grado. A partir de este año, por recomendación de los sacerdotes de la Arquidiócesis, el Arzobispo Sample anunció que la edad de confirmación cambiará a 6.° y 7.° grado, y los estudiantes recibirán el sacramento en la primavera del 7.° grado. Seguirá siendo un proceso de dos años. También habrá un cambio en la forma en que se imparten las clases con un mayor énfasis en el servicio y la participación en la vida de la parroquia en lugar de sentarse en clase todas las semanas; por ejemplo, asistir y participar en los ministerios de la Iglesia: servicio de altar, lectores, ministros de hospitalidad y oportunidades de servicio dedicadas como banco de comida, viajes misioneros o servicio en nuestras cenas de pollo. Habrá oportunidad para el estudio de la Biblia y grupos de oración, oportunidades para la evangelización y oportunidades para que los jóvenes construyan relaciones con sus compañeros en la parroquia. Si tiene un hijo que estará en el grado 6, 7, 8 o 9 este otoño, envíe el nombre de su hijo y su familia a Katie Phelan en la oficina parroquial para que no se pierda el registro.







#### Saint of the Week

Saint Alphonsus was born into a well-respected family in 1696, in Marianella, in the Kingdom of Naples. He received an exceptional education through private tutors and was conferred degrees in civil and canon law at 16. He practiced law for 8 years before he turned to the Church. He was ordained a priest in 1726

Saint Alphonsus traveled for 26 years in Kingdom of Naples preaching. His style of ministry was called "mission among the people," he and a group of priests or lay brothers would go to rural areas, staying for a time to teach, preach, and pray with the people there.

Saint Alphonsus was a brilliant preacher, he was able to connect with ordinary people and his teaching and sermons were marked by his compassion. In a time of restrictive Church rule, where fear of God was truly fear, Saint Alphonsus taught about God's redeeming love. He also had a special devotion to Mary, praying to her for intercession and including devotions to her in his teaching. He wrote extensively, more than 100 books which have been through thousands of editions. His books are still available today and have been translated into more than 60 languages. In 1762 Saint Alphonsus was made a bishop by Pope Clement XIII, however, he was eventually allowed to resign his post because of his ill health. He was paralyzed for a time from rheumatic fever in 1775, and had rheumatism so severe it was deforming, bending his head so far forward that his chin rested on his chest.

He died peacefully at the age of 90 in 1787. He was canonized in 1839 by Pope Gregory XVI, and in 1871 he was named a doctor of the church by Pope Pius IX. In 1950 he was declared patron of moral theologians by Pope Pius XII.
