Dear brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have come to the final Sunday in Ordinary Time this weekend, at least for now. On Wednesday, February 14, we begin our yearly journey into the season of Lent. This is a time in which the Christian faithful enter with Jesus into the forty days that he was in the desert enduring temptation by the devil. During this time of prayer and fasting and alms-giving, we wrestle with those temptations that we face day after day and know that we can overcome these temptations to separate ourselves from God, because Jesus ultimately is victorious and proves that it can be done. Jesus is even there at our side cheering us on and helping us up when we stumble and fall. 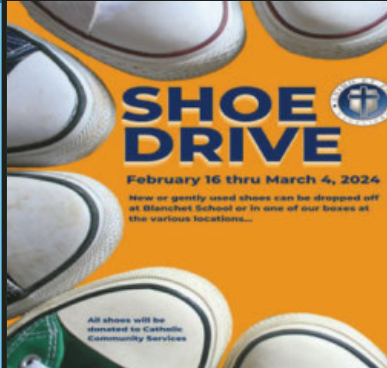
