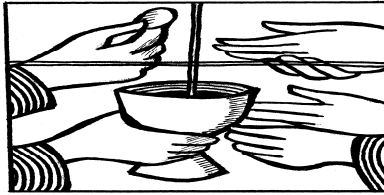
TAKE CHALICE HOME TO PRAY FOR VOCATIONS
