Reflections

We are living in strange times. I mean, under normal circumstances, people can become stressed from the daily grind of everyday life, as well as the complexities of relationships and the challenges that come with making difficult decisions. The fact that mask wearing in public during a global pandemic has become an issue for folks to draw their lines in the sand says a lot, at least to me, about the pressure we're all feeling under the weight of present times.



Generally speaking, I don't make very good choices when I'm over-stressed or over-tired (which is like, always!). Over the past couple of weeks, Fr. Tomasz and Deacon Chris have talked about the need for clarity when making important decisions (or any decisions, really). Fr. Tomasz talked bout asking the 'Why? - Why am I doing the thing that I'm about to do?', and will it be consistent with the life of love I'm trying to live.

Deacon Chris talked about what it means for us to 'Choose God' and asked us what it meant to us that God chose us? What I got from both is that the way to achieve the clarity needed for good decision making is to choose God and let the love that comes with being chosen by God to influence all of life's choices.

Some choices are easy and automatic, 'Should I step in front of this bus, or wait till it goes past?' But many choices are not automatic and are not easy. Many decisions we make involve complex issues that require deep thought. This is a good thing! Bad things can happen when we seek or are offered easy answers to complex questions. We need God in the room with us when we're making difficult choices. This way, we're starting from a place of love, compassion and forgiveness and can go from there. If we are not approaching decisions with God present in our hearts and minds, then we may end up settling for easy answers and, sometimes, that can lead to blaming others for our problems.

In today's Gospel from Mark, Jesus heals a blind man with a speech impediment (Mark 7:31-37). I'm struck by the fact that this man, and others who experience healing encounters with Jesus in Mark's Gospel (the Phoenician woman - Canaanite in Matthew's Gospel - who's daughter was healed after she told Jesus that 'Yes, but even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the master's table' - Mark 7:28-29) - I'm struck by the fact that these individuals, after their encounters with Jesus, went back into their communities, or back to their homes with the words, the presence of Christ still burning in their hearts. We can tell how impactful that word of mouth was by the crowds that followed Jesus throughout Mark's Gospel.

What a blessing it is for us to be able to encounter Jesus freely. We choose God when we allow those encounters into our relationships, and allow them to inform our decisions.

Choose love. Life is hard enough. Choose God.


