#### Reflections:

In our Gospel today from Matthew, Peter continues on his emotional roller coaster. Last week, Jesus calls Peter the 'rock upon whom I'll build my church.' (Matthew 16:18) This week, it's 'Get behind me, Satan.' (Matthew 16:23) Those are strong words for sure, and I can imagine that Peter might have felt hurt by them. To me, the



strong words Jesus had for Peter must have been because Jesus felt that Peter lacked understanding on a fundamental part of Jesus' message and ministry. Perhaps, since Jesus had just entrusted Peter with being the foundation of his church, Jesus is a little disappointed or concerned that Peter would be missing such an essential part of his teaching.

We all have our crosses to bare. There is no way to remove suffering from the equation of our lives. Jesus wants us to try to see God's presence in our suffering, and wants us to know that while we need to walk on our own individual road, Jesus has cleared the path ahead and will walk with us the whole way.

And notice that while Peter may be emotional, he is not fragile. Jesus would not have built his future church on a shaky foundation. It's because of his very human qualities that Jesus sees in Peter a rock upon whom to build. Our messy human qualities, especially ones which we might think make us weakest, are key ingredients to a strong faith, and if we can try to recognize the love that God has for us, and see how that love is woven into the fabric of all our messy human-ness, we can be the church that Jesus built upon Peter.
