Reflections:

In the Gospel of Matthew (6:24), Jesus teaches, "You cannot serve both God and Mammon." Mammon here means wealth, possessions, or the desire for riches. Jesus is not saying that money itself is evil, but that when money becomes our master, it takes the place of God in our hearts. We cannot give our ultimate loyalty to both — our lives can only be centered on one. If wealth drives our choices, then God is pushed aside; but if God is at the center, then money is put in its proper place as a tool, not a master.

This teaching challenges us to examine what motivates us each day. Do we measure success by money, status, or possessions, or do we measure it by love, faithfulness, and service? A person who serves Mammon is never truly satisfied, because wealth can never fill the hunger of the heart. On the other hand, serving God brings freedom and peace, because His love provides what no material possession can. Choosing God over Mammon does not mean rejecting money altogether — it means using what we have responsibly, generously, and without letting it control us.

For Christians, this teaching is a call to trust. When we serve God first, we believe that He will provide for our needs. This allows us to live generously, sharing with others instead of clinging to possessions out of fear. The world often tells us that happiness comes from having more, but Jesus tells us that true joy comes from giving, from trusting God, and from living with our hearts set on heaven rather than on wealth. In the end, serving God leads to eternal treasure, while serving Mammon leaves us empty-handed.
