

FUND A NEED FOCUS

Every year, as part of our fundraising efforts connected to Seton Night Live, there are one or two specific initiatives we focus on. We are very excited to share that this year's Fund A Need focus is on expanding and finishing the unfinished spaces in the basement of the school to make 2 new classrooms. These 2 classrooms will house the new music room and an Essential Skills Class, both of which will hopefully be fully functional by the beginning of school in the fall. With the larger music room, we anticipate being able to offer our students more opportunities to experience this art form through musical instruments, show choir and theatrical productions. The Essential Skills classroom will be an area for a Special Education Teacher and staff to provide additional support to our students who would benefit from it. This will be the first program like it in our Diocese and we couldn't be more excited that it will be available for our current students and other Catholic families in our area. Our goal is to raise \$100,000 to make these spaces and programs possible!



CLASS PARTIES FAQ

1. How many families can host a Class Party?

As many as you like! There's no limit on the number of hosts, but there's one party per grade level.

2. How much money will it cost to host a Class Party?

This is completely up to you! You can keep it simple and plan ice pops at Buckner Park, BBQ or pool party at your home, or you can choose to host with multiple families and have a party at the Roller Dome, ice skating, bowling, etc...

3. How are we bidding on these items for SNL?

We actually will not be bidding on these items for SNL! They will be a ticket purchase on ClickBid (the same way you buy a drink ticket).

4. What about parents who aren't able to attend SNL? Will their kids be left out of buying a ticket to a Class Party?

Absolutely not! Anyone who is registered on ClickBid and able to bid on silent auction items are able to buy a ticket for a Class Party.

5. Are Class Parties only for the kids?

As a host, you can choose what you'd like to do! You can decide if you want to have a party for your child and their peers only, whole families, or a parents only party.
