PASTOR'S CORNER

My Dear Parishioners,

It has already been a year since war was declared between Russia and Ukraine – last Friday, February 24th was its first anniversary. More than 200,000 Russians and 140,000 Ukrainians have perished so far from this war. Let us pray for the leadership – the presidents and the governments involved – that they will immediately get to a peaceful resolution of this conflict.

On March 3, Friday, we celebrate St. Katharine Drexel, who is the second US-born saint after St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. St. Katharine is the patron saint of racial justice and philanthropy, having been very generous with sharing her inheritance the rest of her life. She dedicated her life to the foundation of schools and churches in the missions, particularly benefiting Native Americans and African Americans. She founded about 49 foundations, including the Missionary Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament and Xavier University in New Orleans. She passed away at the age of 97 and was beatified by Pope St. John Paul II in October 2000.

March 4, Saturday, we celebrate the patron saint of Poland and Lithuania: St. Casimir. He was a Polish prince known as the "brother and defender of the poor" who himself led an austere life.

I would also like to remind everybody that since we have entered the season of Lent, we have Stations of the Cross every Friday at 6 PM, preceded by simple suppers at 5 PM, through March 31. *Thank you* to the different Parish ministries who are working together to make these activities possible for us. Lastly, I invite everybody to offer a mini-novena of prayers of thanksgiving to our Lord this Lent. Attend Mass five times and make your communion intention prayer specifically that of thanksgiving for His suffering and death on the cross. On that same day, pray one decade of the Rosary focusing on a Sorrowful Mystery. We so seldom thank Him for His sacrifice and death on the cross so I invite you to do so this Lenten Season.

Parish Announcements

LENTEN REGULATIONS 2023

Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday:

These are days of Fast and Abstinence from meat. There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion. Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.


