### Don't Miss These Symbolisms at Your Next Mass

As Catholics who have gone to countless Masses, we know the order of the different parts of the Mass, and the responses to the priest's prompts come quite instinctively. But most Catholics might miss the symbolisms built in the liturgy because, well, we never knew they were there. Listed here are some of those symbols in words, objects, and gestures.

#### 8th in a Series

#### The Corporal and Altar

The *corporal* is a square or oblong-shaped linen cloth. It is placed on top of the altar, and the Eucharist is placed on top of it. In the older days, the altar was required to be made of a stone slab—usually marble. The entire ensemble of objects is supposed to represent Christ's death; when the priest raises the consecrated host, it is a symbol of Christ raised on the cross. It is also a symbol of Christ's Resurrection, when he rose from the dead from his linen and burial slab.

### How about making a Cursillo weekend?

Cursillo or "short course in Christianity" is an uplifting and educational experience. Weekends are held at the Immaculate Conception Spiritual Renewal Center in Putnam, CT.
