BLESSING OF THROATS FEAST OF ST. BLAISE

Sunday, February 3 is the feast of St. Blaise, Bishop, Martyr and the patron saint of throat illnesses. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. The boy was about to die when Saint Blaise healed him. The traditional blessing of throats will take place next weekend following all of the Masses on February 2 and 3. Allow a little extra time for your family plans if you wish to avail yourself of this traditional Catholic blessing.

WHAT IS GRIEF?

Simply put, grief is a loss. Grief is universal, and each person's journey is unique.

We can respond to our loss in an emotional way, but grief can also have physical, cognitive, behavioral, social, cultural and spiritual dimensions.

When this overwhelming feeling of loss occurs, camaraderie among those who are also experiencing grief can help you navigate through the grieving process.

I am offering a ten-week program called, 'Healing Your Spirit' once a week for an hour and a half. The goal of the program is to help individuals gain a sense of control and empowerment, to help reduce their isolation, maintain self-esteem, and assist in developing trust in others, during these stressful life changes. The program will be under the direction of Peggye Arcouette, a licensed social worker, who is also certified in bereavement.

Parish Prayer Wall

Sadly, all of us know people—perhaps in our families or neighborhoods or friends—who are in particular need of being lifted up to God's mercy in prayer. They are sick and suffering in body or mind. The purpose of our Prayer Wall is to ask God, through the intercession of Our Blessed Mother and patroness, to bring healing to these people. Slips of paper and pencils are available at the wall to write their names or to otherwise describe your prayer intention. The slips of paper are periodically removed from the wall and placed on the altar so that Monsignor can offer a Mass for the intentions. We invite you to take advantage of the powerful opportunity to lift the burdens of your beloved sick.

The Massachusetts House of Representatives and the Massachusetts Senate both have before them a bill to legalize Physician Assisted Suicide (PAS). Both bills are named "An Act relative to End of Life Options". They are to be acted upon sometime during the current legislative session which runs from Jan.2, 2019 and ends Dec.31, 2020.

Co-sponsors representing the Worcester area for the Senate bill are State Senator Harriet Chandler (D-First Worcester) and State Senator Joanne Comerford (D-Hampshire, Franklin, and Worcester). Co-sponsors for the House Bill are State Representative Louis Kafka (D-8th Norfolk) and State Representative Daniel Donahue (D-16th Worcester). 
