

VISITATION HOUSE BABY BOTTLE DRIVE

This weekend we begin our parish participation in the Baby Bottle Fundraiser to benefit Visitation House, a Catholic home for homeless women facing crisis pregnancies. Since opening 14 years ago, on the Feast of the Visitation, Visitation House, located on Vernon Hill in Worcester, has cared for over 250 mothers and their babies. While awaiting the birth of their babies, the women are nurtured by the staff. After the birth of their babies, mothers can stay up to six months, during which time they are assisted in pursuing housing, higher education, job opportunities and gaining knowledge of the basic necessities needed to start their new lives. You can support Visitation House by taking a baby bottle and filling it with your spare money. Bottles may be brought back anytime between now and the weekend of Oct. 26/27.

LEGACY OF HOPE CAMPAIGN

All parishes of the Diocese are joining together for the Legacy of Hope Campaign. This campaign seeks to raise \$32 million over the next four years to prepare our faith community for the future. Our target as a parish is \$393,760. The parish share of 40% is \$157,504 and will be returned to the parish. If we reach the target, the parish will get 60% of that is raised beyond the target. At its heart, this campaign is about creating a legacy by focusing on our parishes, our retired priests, Catholic education, outreach, evangelization and St. Paul Cathedral, the mother church of our Diocese. We are grateful for all who responded so generously to this appeal so far. To date, \$220,000 has been pledged from 122 donors. We have a distance to go to our \$394,000 goal. RELIGIOUS EDUCATION REGISTRATION

Children in public schools or non-Catholic private schools and academics should be attending religious education classes on a yearly basis. Children planning on receiving the Sacrament of First Holy Communion <u>must</u> attend classes for two years (Grade 1 and Grade 2.) Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation <u>must</u> attend classes for two years (Grade 9 and Grade 10.)

Children in parochial schools and private Catholic schools are required to attend classes only for one year (the year of preparation.) First Holy Communion is usually received in Grade 2 and Confirmation in Grades 9 or above. Registration forms are available in the office at the Our Lady of Loreto Center, Monday –Thursday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. and in the vestibule of the church. There is a fee of \$30.00 per child or \$50.00 per family.

CCD Schedule

Classes will begin on Sunday, September 22. Grades Pre-K through Grade 4 will meet on Sunday mornings from 9:00-11:30 a.m. and includes attendance at the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Parents are asked to attend Mass with their children. Attendance in the pre-K and Kindergarten are not mandatory. Grades 5-10 will meet on Sunday mornings from 11:30 a.m. -12:30 p.m. Students are required to attend Mass, it is suggested that they attend the 10:30 a.m. Mass.

Religious Education Parents Meeting

There are two meeting scheduled for parents; On Sunday, September 29 at 9:15 a.m. at the Our Lady of Loreto Center for all parents. These meetings are important, for they will include a description of the programs and will include discussions on the reception of the Sacraments of First Penance, and First Holy Communion.

There will be another meeting on Sunday, September 29 at 11:45 a.m. at the Our Lady of Loreto Center for parents of students planning on receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation either in the spring of 2020. Candidates for the Sacrament of Confirmation <u>must</u> attend classes for two years if they attend a Public school, which includes private schools. (Grade 9 and Grade 10.) Students who attend parochial schools only need to attend one year of CCD.
