**13TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

**July 6, 2023:  
Feast Day of St. Maria  
Teresa Goretti**



**Maria Teresa Goretti** (October 16, 1890 – July 6, 1902) is an Italian [virgin-martyr](#) of the [Catholic Church](#), and one of the youngest [saints](#) to be [canonized](#).<sup>[1]</sup> She was born to a farming family. Her father died when she was nine, and they had to share a house with another family, the Serenellis. Maria took over household duties while her mother, brothers, and sister worked in the fields. One afternoon, [Alessandro](#), the Serenellis' twenty-year-old son, made sexual advances to her. When she refused to submit to him, he stabbed her fourteen times. She was taken to the hospital but she died forgiving him. He was arrested, convicted, and jailed. During imprisonment, he repented. After 27 years he was released from prison and visited her mother to beg forgiveness, which she granted. He later became a [lay brother](#) in a monastery, dying in 1970. She was [beatified](#) in 1947, and canonized in 1950. She is especially venerated in the Congregation of the Passion ([Passionists](#)).

"...whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me." (Matthew 10:38) Pope Benedict XVI said "The world offers you comfort. But you were not made for comfort, you were made for greatness". "Comfort" puts me first. "Picking up your cross and following Jesus" puts God and others first. Why settle for comfort when you can achieve greatness! Pick up your cross, ask Jesus for guidance on using your gifts and live the life God intended for you!

**July 3, 2023: St. Thomas, Apostle**

**Thomas the Apostle, also called Didymus, was one of the Twelve Apostles of Jesus according to the New Testament. Thomas is commonly known as "Doubting Thomas" because he doubted Jesus' resurrection when first told of it; later, he confessed his faith, "My Lord and my God," on seeing Jesus' crucifixion wounds.**
