The Massachusetts Family Institute (MFI) has just learned that Gov. Maura Healey's administration has updated the Comprehensive Health and Physical Education Framework. 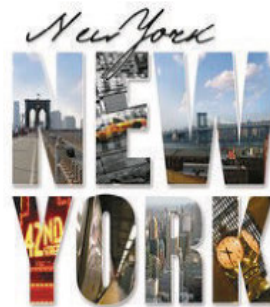
