FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

Winter certainly announced its arrival with the 12+ inches of snow that arrived last weekend and the 2+ inches of rain that greeted us this past Tuesday. As I write this, I understand there is more wet weather coming Friday into Saturday. As you know I canceled Masses last Sunday in the name of safety. A number of people had scheduled Mass intentions, but they will be rescheduled.

In the future, tune into channel 7 for any cancellations. We also send out a Flocknote to everyone who has given us their email address. If you haven't already done so, please call Lisa or Julie at the parish center to give them your email address. It is a quick and convenient way for us to communicate with you.

As you know, I hired Michael Pagano from *Structures* to begin a feasibility study as to where we should construct a new kitchen and gathering space, whether updating the present kitchen in the lower church hall (which the City found outdated and non-compliant with current city and state regulations) or add a new kitchen at the parish center along with a larger gathering space. Michael will present his preliminary recommendations to the parish council. I will certainly keep you informed as we move ahead on this important project.

**BUILDING ON OUR FAITH,
BUILDING ON OUR FUTURE**

For the past several weeks, we have been publishing an announcement entitled *Building On Our Faith, Building On Our Future*. It has been apparent to me and to the Parish and Finance Councils that our revenues from our weekly collections are not meeting our expenses, and haven't for some time, despite significant attempts to trim our expenses. Every week we publish a list of monies collected and how that money is spent and the number the Finance Committee has determined we need to collect in order to meet those expenses - \$8400. Almost weekly we are between \$1500 to \$2500 dollars short. That shortage has mushroomed to a deficit of \$25,000 to \$30,000 annually and it continues to grow. Our yearly Italian Festival raises a significant amount of money, but we cannot rely on this income stream because a lot of variables could affect the amount of money we are able to raise. We cannot allow this shortfall to continue and we must begin to address this serious matter now.

Next weekend we will have Commitment Weekend during which I will respectfully request that each parish family and household prayerfully look at their weekly gift to the parish and, if possible, to increase it. I've asked Dominic Mercurio of our Parish Finance Council to speak at all the Masses next weekend about this vital undertaking. Thank you for your continued support!

RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY
