#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends,

It's hard to believe we are entering into the last weeks of Lent. Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the following Sunday we celebrate the great feast of Easter. When you come to church this weekend, you will notice the statues and cross covered with purple cloth. Why does the Church suggest we do this? First of all, we use veils to alert us of the special time we are in. These purple coverings are a reminder that something is different. These last two weeks of Lent are meant to be a time of immediate preparation for the Sacred Triduum and these veils are a powerful reminder to get ready.

Second, the veils focus our attention on the words being said at Mass. When we listen to the Passion narrative on Palm Sunday and Good Friday, our senses are allowed to focus on the striking words from the Gospel and truly enter into the scene.


Third, the Church uses veils to produce a heightened sense of anticipation for Easter Sunday.

The unveiling before the Easter Vigil is a great reminder of our own lives on earth. We live in a 'veiled' world, in exile from our true home. It is only through our own death that the veil is lifted and we are finally able to see the beauty everywhere in our lives.


# THE PASSION OF THE CHRIST

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

Less: Diocesan Collections

Cash Over/(Short)

& Restricted Funds

**Abstinence** from meat is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.



#### RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

The MA Senate passed the radical Sex Act Mandate, but Speaker Ronald Mariano implied the House would not take up the bill technically killing it for now. The Committee on Consumer Protection and Professional Licensure sent the "Pregnancy Center Gag Rule" to study, which means it is dead for this session. Pregnancy Resource Centers can continue to provide options to abortion. Respect Life organizations and every day citizens flooded their senators and representatives with texts, e-mails and phone calls to oppose these bills, and it worked. But there is still work to be done. The "Radical Abortion Expansion", the Physician Assisted Suicide", "School Vaccine and the "Pornographic School Textbook" bills still remain a threat. 
