## **Guidelines for Lent**

The time of Lent is to be observed by Catholics as a special season of prayer, penance and works of charity.

All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Abstinence refers to the eating of meat of warm blooded animals (e.g. beef, lamb, chicken and pork). Under the present law, it does not include egg or milk products, meat broth or gravies.

The rule of fasting states that only one full meal may be taken per day. Two small meals, "sufficient to maintain strength", are allowed but together that should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals breaks the fast but drinking liquids does not.

The faithful should be clearly and positively encouraged to receive the Sacrament of Penance during Lent.


