



Characteristics of a Potty Trained Child

1. Able to let an adult know of needing to use the toilet.
They must be able to say, "I have to use the potty."
2. Able to pull down pants and underwear before and after using the toilet.
3. Able to wipe themselves after using the toilet.
4. Able to get off the toilet by self or using a step stool.
5. Able to wash and dry hands.
6. Able to rejoin classroom activities without disruption.
7. Able to postpone going to the toilet until an adult is ready to take them or waiting their turn.
