

## Parishioner Fiscal Report for 2025

### Fiscal Year 2025 Financial Highlights

This booklet offers the detailed financial reports for Holy Family Parish – in accordance with the reporting standards of the Archdiocese of Boston. Parishioners who have detailed questions or comments are invited to speak directly with the Parish's Business Manager.

From our detailed actual versus budget financial reports for FY2025, the following facts are significant to note.

- Offertory was favorable to budget by 26%, due to a significant increase in Tithing collections. One thing to note is that online giving has increased over the last 2 years.
- Catholic Appeal for fiscal 2025 was able to raise \$40K, which resulted in a \$11K rebate to the parish.
- The parish received \$10,000 grant from The Catholic Foundation to be used in their evangelization initiatives. The funds were used to purchase the new sound system for the upper church, to set up a special needs sensory room; and to purchase religious education materials.
- Holy Family's Brazilian Community did not have its traditional Festa Junina this fiscal year, but other fundraising efforts were able to bring in funds to meet the budget.
- Tuition revenue was over budget due to two factors: the new religious education fee of \$25 per student from all grades (\$3K) and retreat programs fee (\$10K) (Lent Retreat, Life in the Spirit & Women's retreat).
- Clergy compensation and benefits were under-budgeted for the fiscal year by 25% due to a lack of information on the correct premium amount by the time the budget was put together.
- In prior years, expenses for program activities were not reported at gross (before expenses); therefore, it was under-budgeted for the year because we used a 3-year average method.
- Office expense was over budget by 77% due to IT hardware expenses with the new sound system in the upper church.
- Capital improvements were budgeted under the Facility Expense line. The main capital project for the year was the parish rectory remodel, which was still in progress when the fiscal year closed.
- Pastoral expenses and other expenses line were unfavorable to the budget by 31% and 76%, respectively, due to costs with the youth ministry summer conference, which was not integrated into the budget.


