

## **How to gain access to the MP3 recordings:**



Register your choir for a Pueri Cantores Festival or renew your annual membership.



Once your registration is processed by the AFPC office, you will receive an email with instructions to access the music files from a secure webpage on the AFPC website.

*These rehearsal tracks are carefully recorded in a studio with professional singers, and offer many different listening options for each piece, including the complete work, the individual voice parts, and even the accompaniment alone.*



Just follow the directions in the email, download the MP3s, and start rehearsing!
