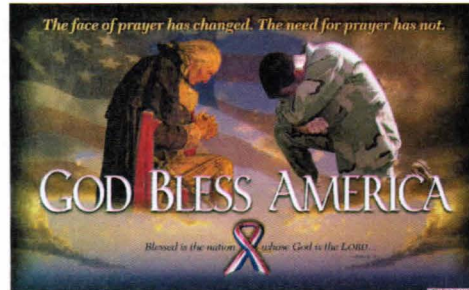

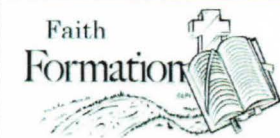
**CHRISTMAS BASKETS**
