As Peter and the other Apostles stand before the Sanhedrin in the First Reading, we remember Jesus' condemnation by that group. The Apostles' preaching has been effective, and the Sanhedrin fears, it will be blamed for Jesus' Crucifixion. Peter boldly asserts that the Apostles are not subject to orders of the court, but only to God, and their preaching is rooted in the tradition of Israel. Surprisingly, they are dismissed with a reprimand and leave "rejoicing that they had been found worthy to suffer dishonor" in Christ's name. Psalms 30 could have been the Apostles' song after their court appearance, for they felt the Lord had delivered them. Like the psalmist, they know the dangers behind and ahead, but their trust and gratitude are firm.

In the Second Reading, John stands in a great throne room, where countless angels surround the throne of the Lord of the cosmos. He hears "everything in the universe cry out" their praise and blessing "to the one who sits on the throne and to the Lamb." This powerful image of the entire universe bowing to the authority of the Father and the Son affirms for Christians of every age and ultimately justice will triumph.

John layers many meanings into his stories. As in other post-Resurrection appearances, the disciples don't recognize Jesus immediately. Still grieving and confused, they have returned to fishing, but Jesus calls them away from their nets once again. That moment of recognition is exciting-for must have felt so familiar-a meal, which included both food Jesus had prepared for them and some they provided from their catch. The conversation with Peter after the meal is a "call" story in which Peter must first pledge his love for the Lord before he is ready for ministry.

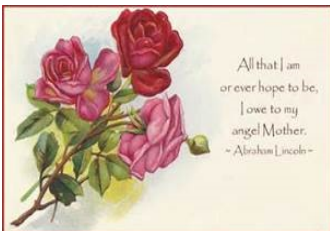

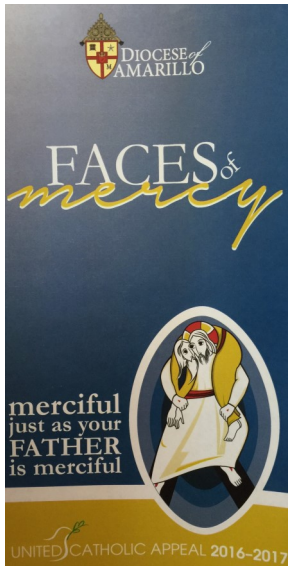

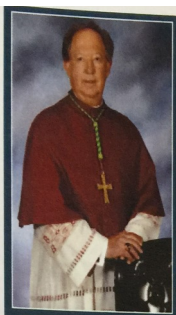

FULANO O FULANA DE TAL, ¿ME AMAS?

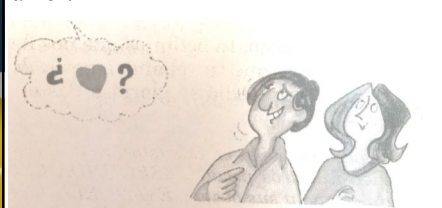
