Biblical prophets speak God's Word to God's people. They come as God's messengers proclaiming an uncomfortable message that challenges their hearers. Throughout the Scriptures, God's prophets encounter opposition and rejection. Today's readings offer there examples of God's messengers of mercy and grace being rejected because of their challenging message. "Hard of face and obstinate of heart are they to whom I am sending you," says God to the prophet Ezekiel. Even though the people of Israel continued to rebel against God by worshipping other gods, God never gave up calling them back.

Because of internal jealousy and revelries, Paul had to defend himself to the Corinthian community that he had founded. Paul lays out his qualifications as an Apostle and prophet sent by God to preach God's message of salvation. When Paul's critics focus on his weaknesses, he shows how God's grace overcomes these weaknesses: "When I am weak, then I am strong."

Jesus also experiences opposition from those who know him best. His home town of Nazareth rejects him. Despite his wisdom and miracles, they arrogantly reject him because, as they say, "Is he not the carpenter, the son of Mary?" Jesus quotes a proverb that says, in essence: "A prophet is only despised in his own country, among his own relatives, and in his own house." He is one of us, so how could he attain such wisdom?

St. Augustine saw jealousy and envy as "the diabolical sin!" Envy keeps us from seeing God working in our world and hinders us from responding to God's vision for our world. Indeed, Jesus "was not able to perform any might deed there."

What does Paul mean when he says: "When I am weak, then I am strong"? Have you ever experienced that in your own life?"

How have you ever experienced jealousy as "the diabolical sin"?

What circumstances have made you aware of your prophetic calling as a Christian?

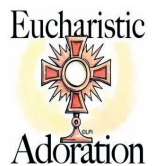

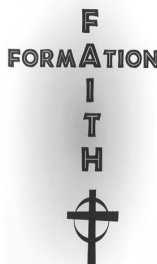

Practice of Faith

We often miss the holiness right in front of us. We expect God's action to be flashy and otherworldly, whereas Scripture and theology tell us that God acts through regular people and everyday events. Reflect on what the Jesuit paleontologist Pierre Teilhard de Chardin wrote: "God is not remote from us. He is at the point of my pen, my pick, my paintbrush, my needle-and my heart and my thoughts". Often, we miss the sacredness of the everyday because we are preoccupied with the past or worried about the future-or, these day's because we have our noses in electronic devices. Take a silent walk in your neighborhood park. Try to be utterly open to what is around you. Cultivate awareness of God's presence. At the end of the day, journal about all the ways God was present to you in the past twenty four hours.

EL APOSTOL SAN PABLO parece estar hablando de esa concupiscencia que arrastramos los humanos desde el pecado original, no como algo malo en el desarrollo de nuestra entrega al Evangelio, sino como una oportunidad para ver la gloria de Dios en nuestras vidas; ya que el poder de Dios se manifiesta a partir de nuestra debilidad.

A medida que vamos tomando conciencia del plan salvífico que Dios tiene para nosotros, vamos también viendo y padeciendo todo tipo de pruebas que el enemigo nos pone por el camino. Esas pruebas son superables con la gracia del Señor Jesús, y se convierten en oportunidades de crecimiento y fortaleza espirituales Sin embargo, esto no quiere decir que sean fáciles de sobrellevar. Pablo mismo les dice a los cristianos de Corinto que ha pedido a Dios por tres veces que le libre de esa “espina clavada en su carne”, a lo cual el Señor le responde: “Te basta mi gracia, porque mi poder se manifiesta en la debilidad”. Que equivocados hemos estado cuando hemos pensado que por estar mas cerca de Dios, las tentaciones y pruebas van a ser menores o mas fáciles de superar! Todo lo contrario.

Cuando el enemigo ve que nos vamos alejando de todo aquello que nos separa de Dios, cuando sabe que nos vamos convirtiendo de la mala vida que hemos venido arrastrando, cuando observa que la gracia del Señor nos va transformando y convirtiendo en un nuevo ser humano, entonces es cuando sutilmente se cuela por las rendijas del ego y se empecina en atacarnos con mas frecuencia y agresividad. El enemigo es listo y nos asaltara en aquellas áreas donde mas seguros nos sentimos y donde mas nos duele.” Te basta mi gracia”, nos dice el Señor, para darnos la certeza de que saldremos victoriosos; porque cuando mas frágiles o vulnerables somos, es cuando realmente se manifiesta el poder de Dios en cada uno de nosotros. Esta es la causa de nuestra alegría como muy bien dice Pablo: “Por eso me alegro....de las dificultades que sufro por Cristo, porque cuando soy mas débil, soy mas fuerte? (2 Cor 12:10)
