SCRIPTURE INSIGHTS

“Woe to the complacent,” shouts the prophet Amos in the First Reading. Indifference to the needs and plight of those around us challenges the prophet Amos and Jesus in today’s readings.

Luke tells the parable in the Gospel in three scenes. In the first, a contrast is drawn between the sumptuous lifestyle of the rich man (who remains unnamed) and the poor man (named Lazarus) covered with sores and lying at the entrance to the rich man’s estate. There Lazarus dies, forgotten, with no mention of burial. The rich man also dies and is buried.

The next scene takes place in the afterlife, where the roles are reversed and Lazarus is with Abraham while the rich man is in torment. In the final scene, the rich man begs that his brothers be warned about their fate for overlooking the poor. Like the rich man and his brothers, we have the teachings of Scripture, but we also have the example from this parable and more importantly that of Christ, to remind us of our responsibility to care for the needs of others. Christians can never be indifferent to the needs of the injustices done to others. Pope Paul VI said in Populorum progression, 23, “It is well known how strong were the words used by the Fathers of the Church to describe the proper attitude of persons who possess anything towards persons in need. To quote Saint Ambrose; ‘You are not making a gift of your possessions to the poor person. You are handing over to him what is his. For what has been given in common for the use of all, you have abrogated to yourself:’

Why do you think that the poor man is named but not the rich man?

Why do we have a responsibility to help those who are in need?

How has your life been touched or changed when you have responded to someone in need?

Tu vives con los pobres, Señor

El profeta Amos advierte que los ricos quedan atrapados en frivolidades, y que la fascinación por lo que disfrutan, no les permite ver el futuro. La riqueza nubla la conciencia de que todo se pasa, distrae, y no visualiza donde terminan los días de placer y comienza la justicia de Dios. También san Pablo a Timoteo le advierte que la raíz de múltiples males es el amor al dinero.

Lucas continua con la tema de los pobres y los ricos, pero ahora con un relato dramático nos dice que la realidad de Dios es opuesta a la lógica del tener. Los dos personajes de esta parábola están próximos, pero el que lleva ventaja, se mantiene ignorante de la desventaja del otro. El pobre Lázaro frente al rico nos dice que la coexistencia de pobres y ricos es temporal y que la condición de unos y otros queda invertida. En este presente, preparamos nuestro futuro y ese futuro esta mas próximo de lo que imaginamos. Al morir, la vida que ahora llevamos no podrá continuar lo que ocurra tras la muerte es irreversible, pero dependerá de lo que elijamos hacer ahora, y lo llevemos a cabo.

En los dos personajes de la parábola, el evangelio resalta la impotencia. Antes de morir, Lázaro no tuvo posibilidad para tomar siquiera las sobras del rico; después de morir, el rico, sumergido en tormentos, es impotente para darse refrigerio o para ayudar a sus hermanos. La realidad no es tan flexible en el mas allá. Lucas nos advierte sobre la indiferencia hacia los pobres. El rico sabe el nombre del pobre, si noto su existencia, pero fue indiferente a su necesidad. Cuando el rico pide clemencia a Abraham, el patriarca le recuerda que el ya sobreabundo y que ignora los males del pobre. Podría decirse que el rico tenía buenas intenciones por sus familiares y quiere evitar su misma suerte, pero el apego a las riquezas cierra el corazón. Por lo mismo cabe preguntarse, si necesitamos escuchar algo mas sobre la solidaridad con los que sufren, para llegar a cambiar nuestros modos de vida.

Podemos ver a la grandes santos y santas de Dios acercarse con compasión al dolor, a al enfermedad, a la carencia máxima, pero sus ejemplos, desgraciadamente no nos mueven a imitarlo. Podemos conocer los libros sagrados o doctrinas, pero no nos incomodamos para transformar la desigualdad. Los padres de la Iglesia hacían notar a los cristianos que se percataran de que el verdadero pobre era el rico, porque se vería privado de todo.

CUIDADO CON LAS RIQUEZAS!

La parábola del rico y el pobre Lázaro es un llamado a no permanecer indiferentes ante el drama de los demás. Dios no quiere que vivamos en la miseria, sino que elijamos lo mejor para todos. Que el apego a los bienes de este mundo no nos aleje de Dios y de los hermanos.

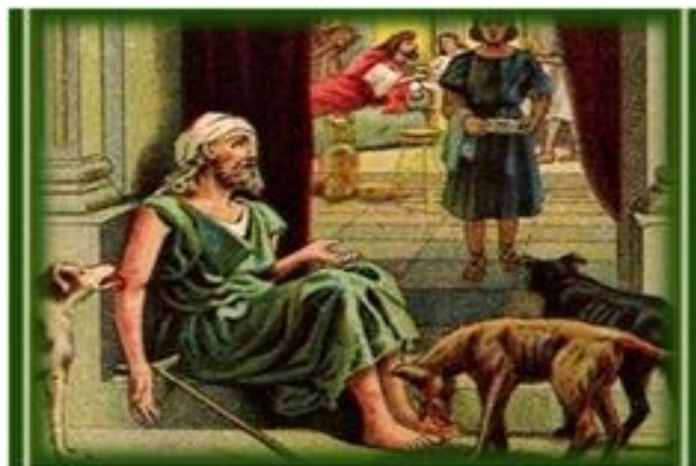
