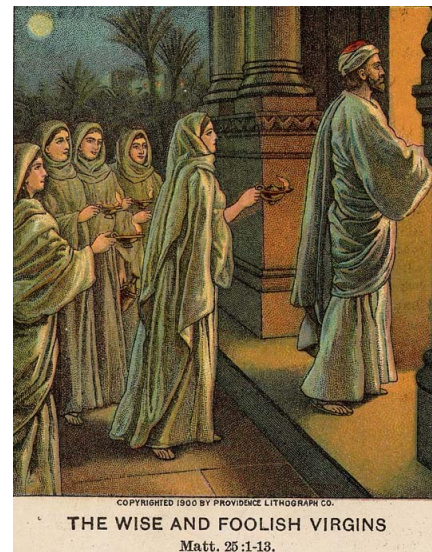

Gospel Matthew 25:1-3 Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus told his disciples this parable: “the kingdom of heaven will be like ten virgins who took their lamps and went out to meet the bridegroom. Five of them were foolish and five were wise. The foolish ones, when taking their lamps, brought no oil with them, but the wise brought flasks of oil with their lamps. Since the bridegroom was long delayed, they all became drowsy and fell asleep. At midnight, there was a cry, ‘Behold, the bridegroom! Come out to meet him!’ then all those virgins got up and trimmed their lamps. The foolish ones said to the wise, ‘give us some of your oil, for our lamps are going out.’ But the wise ones replied, ‘No, for these may not be enough for us and you. go instead to the merchants and buy some for yourselves.’ While they went off to buy it, the bridegroom came and those who were

Ready went into the wedding feast with him. Then the door was locked. Afterwards the other virgins came and said, ‘Lord, Lord, open the door for us!’ But he said in reply, ‘Amen, I say to you, I do not know you.’ Therefore, stay awake, for you know neither the

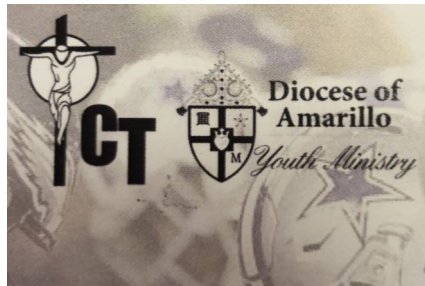

Comprometerse en la tarea

Las celebraciones de todos los Santos y de Todos los Fieles Difuntos han sido un memento de especial intensidad espiritual porque nos unen de un modo muy peculiar a aquellos que “nos han precedido en el signo de la fe y duermen el sueño de la paz” (ver el Canon Romano). Hemos recordado y honrado a los cristianos que fueron antes que nosotros y que vivieron sus virtudes heroicamente. Esto, en primer lugar, supone confesar que si se puede vivir el Evangelio en la vida diaria, que el proyecto cristiano es válido y realizable, y que muchos lo han hecho ya. Por eso están en el cielo.

Por eso, este domingo las lecturas nos dicen que la cosa empieza desde aquí abajo, desde la cotidianidad de vivir en familia e ir a trabajar, desde el amor y el pan de cada día. El verdadero sabio sabe lo que es la sabiduría y no se separa de ella. Cada domingo (o usted quizás cada día) los cristianos nos acercamos a la Palabra de Dios para conocer la sabiduría, aprenderla, recordarla y vivirla. El secreto está en hacer la obra completa, los cuatro pasos. A sabio (y a santo) se llega solo escuchando, porque ya sabemos que hay cosas que nos entran por un oído y nos sale por el otro.

La parábola de las vírgenes sabias es muy educativa. Nos propone un ejemplo habitual en la época de Jesús y que los que escuchaban entendían bien. La historia nos cuenta que algunas compañeras de a novia esperaban al prometido como se debía. Es decir, sabían que vendría, aprendieron lo que haría falta, recordaron preparar provisiones de aceite para la espera y esperaron pacientemente. Pero su espera fue activa, porque estaban preparadas y atentas a la llegada del novio. Nuestra vida cristiana es exactamente igual. Jesús se hace presente en cada acontecimiento y en cada ámbito de la vida. Hay que estar preparado para identificar donde y cuando se nos manifiesta el Señor. Viene a nuestro encuentro.

La parábola también ofrece un lado triste: desgraciadamente hay otras acompañantes vírgenes que son necias. Ellas también escucharon, pero ni aprendieron ni recordaron, y cuando les tocó vivir su momento, no estaban preparadas. Nos preparamos a la venida del Señor. Por eso, cada domingo hay que pisar tierra y tomar conciencia de que ser cristiano no es automático; hay que trabajar duro con el propio ser y con la vida para ser un verdadero discípulo de Cristo, y acompañarlo al banquete de bodas.

NO SABEMOS NI EL DÍA NI LA HORA

Dios nos ama. Es por eso que hoy, en la parábola de las jóvenes descuidadas y las previsoras, Jesús nos pone de nuevo en alerta para que estemos siempre listos para el encuentro definitivo con él; no sea que en aquel momento nos halle con las manos vacías.

No podemos detener el tiempo....

Mejor será estar preparados para ese día.
