Distribution of Holy Communion Under Both Species Update

With the abating of the pandemic, Bishop McManus has directed the office for Divine Worship to announce the restoration of all prior liturgical practices, including his renewal of his permission to pastors to distribute Holy Communion under both species to the faithful, effective Easter Sunday, April 9, 2023.

The Bishop has empowered the pastors to decide when they deem it appropriate to distribute Holy Communion for their parish.

Fr. John Larochelle is in the process of ensuring both our Eucharist Ministers and Congregation are prepared for this return. With that said, Divine Mercy will start distributing both species late April. The established date will be provided in a future bulletin and at Mass.
