



Pastor's Corner

Reflection: One writer has described our present age as follows: “We are surrounded by information but are strangers to wisdom. We are addicted to politics but indifferent to principle. We are driven by acquisition but contemptuous of sacrifice. We are fascinated by self-analysis but numb to the needs of others. We are preoccupied with our bodies but careless with our souls. We are attentive to gossip but deaf to the Word. We love to talk religion but are fearful of sharing our faith.” This is something we need to reflect on. God’s plan is to save us from all corruption and sin.

The inner transformation that Jesus came to bring about in the human soul is the necessary condition for any abiding change in our family and in our society. A corrupt heart will corrupt everything it touches. A healed heart will transform everything it touches.

Advent is a perfect time to assess ourselves and identify whatever is keeping us from experiencing this renewing power of our Lord. Part of the joy of Advent comes from the knowledge that Jesus Christ came to bring life to the dead places of our heart, to remove the desert of sin in our lives and to help us recover spiritual vitality in our soul.

Let us all cry out: “Lord come and save us!”

At that time Mary got ready and hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea, where she entered Zechariah's home and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting...she was filled with the Holy Spirit." (Lk 1:39-40)

The Visitation Reflection: "She got ready and hurried".

Mary, who lives the experience of the living God, in her own being, shows us the essential value of relationships and communication in the dynamism of creation. Natural life on Earth is only possible through the establishment of harmonious relationships and healthy (ecological) communication between each living being and the environment, and between living beings. The Life that drives the dynamism of creation is also transmitted as a spiritual force with the word that is communicated: "He heard the greeting and was filled with the Spirit of God", which is the strength of our strength (see LS 40,28-31). Pope Francis reminds us that God has stamped the dynamism of the Holy Trinity in all creation and insists that "everything is connected" (LS 116, 91, 117, 138, 240), ... "This leads us not only to marvel at the manifold connections existing among creatures, but also to discover a key to our own fulfillment. The human person grows more, matures more and is sanctified more to the extent that he or she enters into relationships, going out from themselves to live in communion with God, with others and with all creatures... Everything is interconnected, and this invites us to develop a spirituality of that global solidarity which flows from the mystery of the Trinity" (LS240).

This Advent let us be like Mary: ready to communicate the strength of God and transform creation.

Prayer before shopping:

Thank you, Lord, for all Your gifts. For bestowing upon us the necessary food and things of daily use.

Do not let material possessions separate us from You, the Supreme Good. Open our hearts to Your love, which You show to us through the closeness of our brothers and sisters and the beauty of Your creation. Free us from attachment to the things we possess and enable us to share sacrificially with those who have less than us.

As Christmas draws near teach us to be content with what is necessary. Protect us from greed and waste. May our daily choices serve to achieve justice in the world not exploitation of the planet and its poor. We ask for the needed wisdom, sensitive hearts, and the virtue of moderation, so that when we purchase goods we are guided not only by our own benefit, but by concern for the common good, the right of workers, the proper treatment of animals and the consequences for the environment. Amen.


