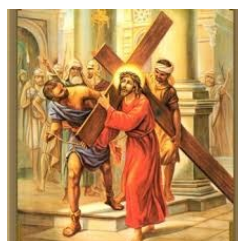

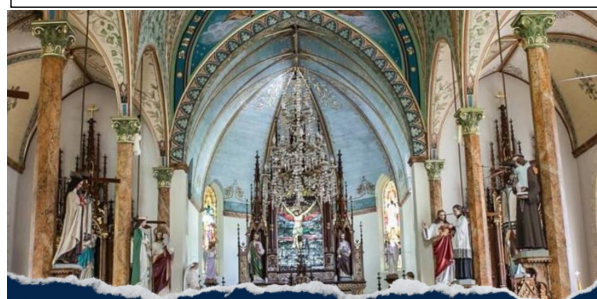

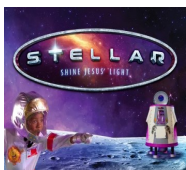

The current president of CYO is resigning from this organization. Through no fault of the current leadership, it is readily apparent that this organization is at a crossroads. However, the biggest issue facing the organization is the lack of volunteers needed to take on the management of the St. Ann CYO organization. This issue is not isolated only to our parish. Many other parishes are looking at this organization because of the same issues. Another factor to consider is that only 10% of the youths participating in this Catholic organization are parishioners of St. Ann parish. While this is a valuable youth organization, without volunteers, it cannot function. As of right now we have no one that has stepped up to volunteer. A new president must be selected by April 1st so the current president can assist in training them for the job at hand. Anyone interested in leading or being a part of this organization, please call the office and let Father Johnson know. Without new leadership, there is a high probability that at the very least, St. Ann may have to take a year's absence from participating in CYO.

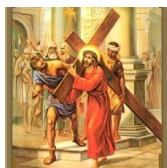

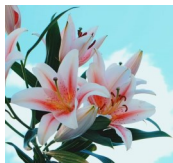

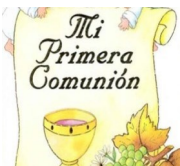
