What is RCIC? Does my Child need it?

RCIC stands for Rite of Christian Initiation adapted for Children. If your child is 7-years-old through 12th grade and needs to be baptized, they will be placed in our wonderful program, RCIA for Children (RCIC)

RCIA for Children participants attend the 9:00 AM Mass on Sundays. During Mass they are dismissed after the homily (around 9:30) for Breaking Open the Word and their regularly scheduled class. Class will dismiss at 11:15am during the scheduled faith formation time. All of the children and teens will receive Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation during the Easter Vigil Mass.

This class is also for students who may be behind on the sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation. 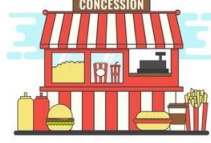

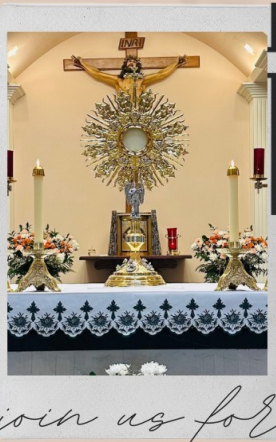


Meet our Night of Worship Speaker
