THANKSGIVING

Thanksgiving is a national holiday celebrated in the United States and only a handful of other countries. It began as a day of giving thanks and sacrifice for the blessing of the harvest and of the preceding year. Although Thanksgiving has historical roots in religious and cultural traditions, it has long been celebrated as a secular holiday as well. On December 26, 1941, President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed a resolution of Congress changing the national Thanksgiving Day to the fourth Thursday in November. What Americans call the "Holiday Season" generally begins with Thanksgiving.

November is both a beginning and an end. The Feast of Christ the King, also called the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, on November 20 is celebrated on the last Sunday of the liturgical year. The next Sunday, November 27, is the First Sunday in Advent, the start of the new liturgical year.
