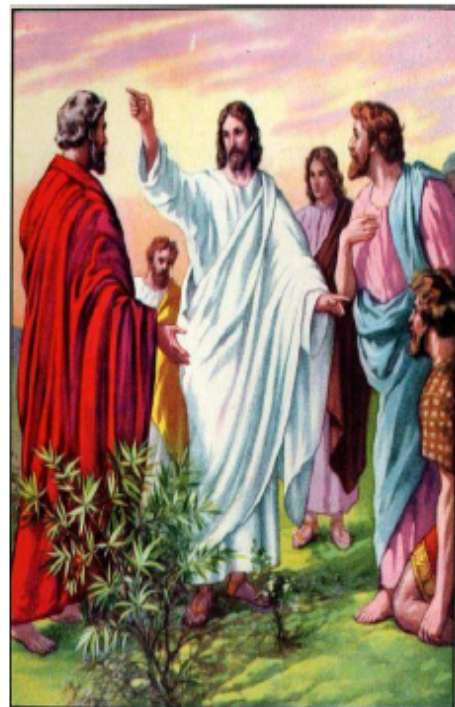

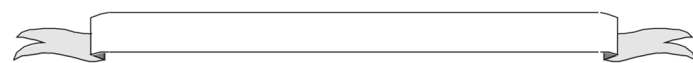

Lent is a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We begin the season of Lent this week with Mass on Ash Wednesday at 9:00 am. There will be three Liturgies of the Word at 12:00 noon, 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm. Ashes will be sprinkled for each liturgy.

The season of Lent is forty days of preparation for the highest day of the year, when we will welcome new members into the Catholic Faith. The highest day of the year, Easter, the day of the victorious rising of Jesus from the dead. The day that the Son of God and the Son of Mary, Jesus, defeated Satan and conquered sin and death.

Lent is a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Fasting to free ourselves from some of our habits which distract us from loving God and our neighbor with all our hearts, all our souls and all our minds. We fast to give up the something not necessary for our good health and our well-being.
