Fasting and Abstinence

The three disciplines of Lent are prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

Prayer

Take advantage of the extra opportunities our parish is offering this lent; the Lenten Mission, the Lenten Retreat, Stations of the Cross, and all the many prayer opportunities available to you.

Fasting

Fasting is reducing food intake.

Abstinence

Abstinence is refraining from certain foods, in particular meat.

As Catholics, we (those 18 - 59) are obligated to fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday & abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent.

Almsgiving

Use the Lenten envelopes at the church doors or give to a favorite charity.

Seen as ways to grow closer to God and express penitence, these practices are intended to foster spiritual growth and self discipline.

OLH/SL 70th Anniversary Commemorative Book


