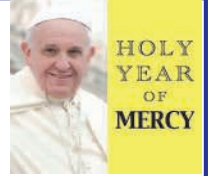

6th Week-Mar. 20 Bury the Dead

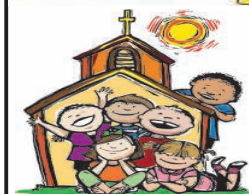

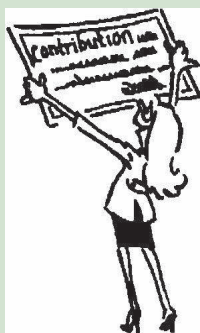
