On that day, the promise you gave of your Spirit was fulfilled to the whole world.


As these newly confirmed go out into the world preserve the gifts of the Spirit in their hearts.



All Saints' Day, Nov. 1, is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven. It should not be confused with All Souls' Day, which is observed on Nov. 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven.

Although millions, or even billions of people may already be saints, All Saints' Day observances tend to focus on known saints -- that is those recognized in the canon of the saints by the Church.

All Souls' Day, Nov. 2, is a holy day set aside for honoring the dead and we offer prayers to those in purgatory. Reverend Donohoe said, "All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day are related, but they are two separate celebrations. On All Saints' Day there's a call to live as saints, to remind us how we're supposed to live. On All Souls' Day, we're talking about all souls




