What to expect when you're expecting.....

Friends,

This was the title of a book several years ago for women who were pregnant and were "expecting" a baby, outlining a series of "heads ups" for the things which parents face in the first year or of having a little one.

I'd like to offer similar advice to us as we "expect" to enter the autumn together. The summer has been frankly a busy one. Mergers, moves, and in all truth, the setting up of systems, offices, and more that will allow us to do all of the things were expecting.

Thankfully the first thing that we can expect is a return of many people to Mass. We are seeing roughly 300 folks at Good Shepherd and 400 at St Christopher's in the summer now, which has improved since Lent. That's great news considering that the summer is traditionally the worst time of the year. With that being the case - I think we can be hopeful that the numbers for weekend Masses will continue to rise.

We can expect full churches with families since we're making Mass the baseline for CCD, not class, projects or service hours. Honestly w/out Mass, it's a course on religion not a life in Christ.

We can expect some friction when people might "take your seat" or the parking spot.

We can expect more opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration and confessions.

We can expect preaching which is consistent on themes related to the liturgical seasons, readings and even about the path and direction we're headed as a parish and even the lives of the saints which have proved very popular. We can expect to promote our social events like breakfasts and have more co-ordination with both the Red Hook and Rhinebeck parishioners and work together on charitable service.

We can expect smarter scheduling with things like Stations of the Cross in Lent. We'll have a 4pm at St Chris before the Fish Fry and the 7pm at Good Shepherd, not two at the same time.

We can expect using St Joseph's Chapel in Rhinecliff for lovely feasts like All Souls Day....

We can expect celebrations of First Penances and First Communions with small parties afterwards and Egg Hunts at Easter after the main Masses at both churches...

We can also expect....difficulties, misunderstandings, goofed schedules and all that comes with (God-willing) almost 1,000 people sharing four roofs (school, SC, GS and the chapel).

We can also expect God's grace, God's forgiveness and God's love to bring us together and back as a parish family in ways that will amaze us if we allow Him to lead.

So – is that what you were expecting? But like any mom and dad know....there will always be more to expect and many surprises too. May God always be the center of our Catholic faith and help us to expect great things from Him! What is he expecting from us?
