Do I pray seriously for quality time each day? Do I know what the voice of God sounds like in my prayer? Do I use His name poorly, or joke, tempt or treat Him like an add-on in my life rather than it's center? Since my last confession do I skip Mass without a real serious reason? Am I prepared and focused to the best of my ability at Mass? What is my family life like? Are there longstanding grudges, do I care for my kids or my parents in a truly Christian way. If my parents are sick or homebound do I make arrangements for them spiritually as well as medically? Do I show my children love? Am I always giving advice? Am I careless with my duty as a Catholic parent? Do I pray with my children? Do I let my children walk all over me? Have I ever taken someone's life? Have I harmed another person seriously? Have I helped others to do away with someone because of threats or convenience? In thoughts or deeds do I engage in sins of impurity? Cheated on a spouse in person or online? Do I owe anyone a large amount of money with no thought of repaying? Do I cheat on taxes? Do I give to God what is right or am I stingy with God? As an employee do I give an honest days work? As a boss do I exploit my workers or make unreasonable demands? Do I lie, gossip, spread truth to hurt people? Am I sinfully envious of others life, possessions, marriage or lifestyle? All of these are sometimes all too common and create a barrier we make ourselves to others and God.
