

"How'd you do it?," a longtime St Chris parishioner on the finance council said. "For years—all we heard about was deficits at St Chris, the need for more fundraising and how we are always behind the 8 ball. Now I read in the bulletin that (basically) we're good?"

I replied to him that when we had the chance to consolidate we did, when a few staff retired we split remaining duties and gave some slight raises instead of new employees, and we brought Mass attendance up. In the end, lower expenses in costs, lay salaries, no other full time priests (not always optimal, ha) and also higher collections did it at St Chris—not me.

While there is some room for occasional fundraisers — many parishes go out of control — they sap energy from our primary job of worshiping God, forming disciples, and serving others. Jesus never said, "Go out to all the world....and take a second collection" Jesus told His followers — "Make disciples..." not money. Providentially, when we do worship, formation, and service of others right, we will do just fine. Studies show if God has our heart....He'll have our wallet. If he doesn't he'll get the change in the pocket.

We had a finance meeting in May 2022 when the accountant said we need \$9,200 a week" at St Christopher's to cover everything without relying on fundraisers. Generally, we are halfway there (roughly \$8,400 avg from \$7,700 last year avg).

The remaining gap can be bridged by our younger parents and CCD population. Without envelopes or WeShare we lose out because many younger folks & families, including middle aged folks like me, just simply don't carry cash anymore or haven't written a check in years. Please consider – especially if you're 50 or younger—to help the parish by enrolling in WeShare – and then "set it and forget it" to focus on making and being the disciples He calls us to be."

Thanks to all of you as we continue to make progress in our parish life after COVID. It's also important to say a big thank you to our senior citizens — who "pound for pound" brought us through the worst of that time by their attendance at Mass and fidelity to our parish in the envelopes. Know that I & our parishioners—owe you a huge debt of gratitude. Bravo!




"Roger's Run" last Saturday was a great event locally in Red Hook for one of our religious ed kids and faithful Mass-goer and all around inspiration Roger!


It looks like he'll be teaching at a higher ed post this coming year so I know he'll do great!


