December 9th is the next Food Pantry at St Christopher's School Building.


Maybe come by and see about volunteering—some folks may just want a smile and conversation.

There are phones in the sacristy and one on me. In the event that we need it I'm sure we'll be fine. However, free yourself to pray, to <u>practice being in His Presence without distraction</u> and even after at social hours to have conversations without the crutch of the phone.

Maybe even ask Santa for a flip phone? It might save you more than money but your sanity, your peace and your prayer life.




