Last week we were able to sit down with parents of our CCD kids to do some house-keeping and goal setting. I don't generally like meetings, as most meetings can usually be emails. I figure once a year however isn't a killer for people plus it's a good way to just connect when kids aren't there and look at dates for Confirmation and Communion as well as hand out report cards (because the kids always lose them or put them in a pocket to be discovered in July).

I hope it also creates on "easy on ramp" for our folks to experience a really renewing Lent which starts on Wednesday, February 14th—Valentine's Day—a reminder of God's intense love for us and the love we are meant to reflect back to Him and others. That love, in a concrete way is called reverence.

Everything in the culture seems more up close, more immediate, and often irritating how do we make space for the transcendent, the mystical and the reverent. In fact most therapists will tell us that the more creative, mystical and quiet we can be—the more mentally healthy we will be. Isn't that what the Catholic church has been saying for about 2,000 years? Isn't this why some of the most advanced souls in the history of the saints can be so string and rooted even as the world collapses around them.

So how do we help all people: grandparents, parents, kids, and frankly, everyone to start or continue to assist at Mass with reverence, to serve, sing, read, and just be comfortable in silence in His Presence? We are hoping that each family, in CCD or not might rather give up an hour this Lent per week than something like chocolate, PS5, social media or alcohol and set a time to be with Our Lord in the Eucharist.

I'm also asking all our parish groups to also commit as individuals to do this. All of us, including priests can get uprooted from our source: God. We do a million things—even for the Church—and feel exhausted but jump right back on the hamster wheel of busyness—but because it's church busyness we can be deluded into thinking it's better than "other people" who are running around with sports or other things, but it's no different. In fact, in ministering, we actually need it more.

Let's relax and re-set this Lent. Take this commitment form home, really pray and write what you can do. There will be books, rosaries, and sheets to help guide you to pray during this silent time. It will be weird for some at first, people often now are unused to quiet (even in church) and these guides can help you pray better.

We've set up times at both churches—two that coincide with CCD at St Christopher's and others that work into after work and school hours near Rhinebeck. I'm taking an hour, the staff is committing to an hour, even kids are taking an hour, will you?




