In November of this year the building of our current St Christopher's Church turns 100 years old! But the parish is older than that -

St. Joseph's Church in Rhinecliff was the "Mother" parish at the start and later branched out into Sacred Heart Barrytown down by the Red Hook Boat Club. Before then, and before cars and bridges if the faithful from Red Hook, Tivoli, and Barrytown, couldn't travel to St. Joseph's, the other option was to go to church in Saugerties. This meant crossing the Hudson River by boat in the summer or by walking across the ice in the winter.

The Catholic population continued to grow in the area and eventually the need for other church became necessary near Tivoli, hence the start of St Sylvia's. However, there was still a great necessity to serve the Catholics in Red Hook. In the early 1920s, Mass was made available in Red Hook in the old Lyceum Theater on West Market Street, the building in front Charlie O's. This situation was not appealing to many parishioners!

On February 10, 1925 the property on the corner of South Broadway & Garden Street was purchased for the future church. St. Christopher's cornerstone was laid on November 8, 1925. It became a mission church of Sacred Heart.

The Parish functioned as one Church, with two church buildings and the pastor residing in Barrytown.
